

FAQ - JAB

Who can apply?

Only Junior Year Students. Juniors are those who will be graduating in June 2018 (Academic year September – June) or in December 2017 (Academic year February – December).

When can I apply for the JAB's next selection?

Registration for the Junior Advisory Board 2017 will open shortly.

Where is it taking place?

Both IE University Campuses (Segovia and Madrid).

Until when can I apply?

January 27th, 2017 (no exceptions).

Is there an application fee?

No, there is no application fee for JAB.

Do I have to submit all the documents at the same time?

Yes, Documents submitted at different times will not be considered.

Is there a minimum GPA requirement?

We're looking for well-rounded students with a wide variety of interests, talents and opinions. There is no minimum GPA requirement, although your academic record is taken into account when looking at applications.

I don't speak Spanish. Is this a problem?

No, this is not a problem. All interactions during the JAB summer meeting are in English.

If I am selected as a member of the Junior Advisory Board, what will I have to do?

If you are selected as a member of the JAB, you will be expected to attend the annual meeting in Madrid and remain in contact with IE University for future developments.

Will I have to pay for my travel to Spain and other associated costs (food, in country travel, housing)?

No, all of your essential costs (food, housing, transportation) will be covered by IE University. You will likely want to bring your own funds to cover personal expenses, such as souvenirs and snacks.

Will I get to meet the other JAB members before the meetings?

If selected, you will be invited to join the JAB Facebook group.

What happens if I have class or important activities during the JAB meeting?

We will do our best to schedule the meeting during dates, which do not oppose a conflict for any of our members. If you have a serious commitment, we will work with you so that you can participate as fully as possible.

Will the JAB be a serious time commitment?

Being a member of the JAB requires you to stay in touch with the organizers to make arrangements for you and to attend all four days of the meeting in April.

Who could do my recommendation letter?

The recommender should be a counselor, professor or someone with whom you have worked with, He/she should not be your relative.
